WHY DO WE PREACH?

The preaching of the Word is one of the key ways that God moves, by His Spirit, today.

Preaching has the power to awaken new affections for God

1 Corinthians 1:21 NLT

Since God in his wisdom saw to it that the world would never know him through human wisdom, he has used our foolish preaching to save those who believe.



WHY DO WE PREACH?

1. We have good news

Romans 10:13-15 ESV

For “everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.”

How then will they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how are they to believe in him of whom they have never heard? And how are they to hear without someone preaching? And how are they to preach unless they are sent? As it is written, “How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the good news!”

2 Timothy 4:1-2 ESV

I charge you in the presence of God and of Christ Jesus, who is to judge the living and the dead, and by His appearing and His kingdom: preach the word; be ready in season and out of season; reprove, rebuke, and exhort, with complete patience and teaching.

Exegesis - The process of analysing and interpreting the Bible to understand its intended meaning.

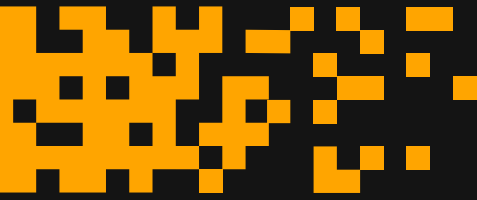
